

Instructions for Worship

August 8, 2021

Because of the increase in Covid cases in Lancaster County, the severity of the Delta virus, and the fact that our children cannot yet be vaccinated, the Leadership Team is asking the following:

1. That everyone wear a mask in the church building. Masks can be removed when seated, except for during singing. Masks should be worn when sharing at the microphones in the audience. Masks are not required for people when they are leading from the platform.
2. Enter through the doors at the main lobby. The other doors will be locked. Greeters will be masked and vaccinated.
3. Building areas accessible to congregation: lobby, sanctuary, and restrooms only. Beginning on September 5, additional areas will be used for Sunday School. *(All areas that are used need to be cleaned following the worship service each week).*
4. An offering basket is in the back of the seating area.
5. Children, ages 3 through Grade 5, individual bags of toys, crayons, etc. are provided in the lobby.
6. There is no nursery provided. Parents are welcome to take young children to the back of the sanctuary. Parents provide toys for children ages 2 & younger.
7. Anyone serving communion will be masked and vaccinated.
8. An air filter system has been installed in the building, including the sanctuary.

Notes:

1. If you test positive for Covid-19 after attending a worship service, please report this to Pastor Dawn ASAP for contact tracing so that we can keep other people safe.
2. Everyone's name who is in attendance is written down by the folks in the sound booth for contact tracing.
3. Congregants are asked to stay home if they are sick or have had close contact with a person with COVID-19. Follow CDC guidelines before returning to worship.
