

"Feed the Children" Volunteers Needed: Tuesday, July 13, 1:45-5:30 p.m.: "Feed the Children" reached out to the New Holland Early Learning Center last week about hosting an event at our location. Tyson Food and Americold (cold storage) reached out to Feed the Children to do a 10 city tour in which they donate the following to 320 families in need: 1) Food box (non-perishable food. Approximately 25-28 lbs). 2) Box of Tyson protein (25 lbs), 3) 400 essential boxes of personal care items (12-15 lbs), 4) Avon boxes (5 lbs), 5) Children's books. Instructions for Worship in Sanctuary

Because of the high number of people in our church who have been vaccinated and the changes in CDC guidelines, we are suggesting the following:

- 1. People who are vaccinated do not need to wear masks or social distance. Anyone not vaccinated is encouraged to wear a mask indoors for their own safety (and the safety of the children) when not seated and during singing and are encouraged to social distance from others.
- 2. Building areas accessible to congregation: lobby, sanctuary, and restrooms only. (All areas that are used need to be cleaned following the worship service each week).
- 3. Enter through the doors at the main lobby. The other doors will not be unlocked.
- 4. Offering baskets will be placed at the back of the sanctuary instead of being passed during the worship service.
- 5. No nursery. Parents are welcome to take young children to the back of the sanctuary. Parents provide toys for children ages 2 & younger.
- 6. Children, ages 3 through Grade 5, individual bags of toys, crayons, etc. provided.
- 7. Sharing time: go to microphones on stand in aisle to share. Pastor Dawn and a leadership team member will serve communion to people at the front since they are vaccinated.
- 8. A Zoom link will be available for anyone who is not able to attend in person.
- 9. An air filter system has been installed.

Note:

- 1. If you test positive for Covid-19 after attending a worship service, please report this to Pastor Dawn for contact tracing so that we can keep other people safe.
- 2. Congregants are asked to stay home if they are sick or have had close contact with a person with COVID-19. Follow CDC guidelines before returning to worship.
